Under the responsibility of the Research Grants Office, which reports to the Vice President for Research and Graduate Studies, the Post-Approval Monitoring Veterinarian is responsible for all post-approval monitoring activities in the context of animal testing.

As such, she or he implements, in collaboration with colleagues, all the measures necessary to ensure that research and teaching activities involving animals comply with standard operating procedures, applicable regulations and standards of the Canadian Council on Animal Care (CCAC).




RESPONSIBILITIES

- Works in collaboration to ensure the structuring, implementation and sustainability of a post-approval monitoring program that meets the requirements of the CCAC and actively participate in the activities of this program.
- Supports research teams before launching any new experiment and validates their training and advice needs.
- Is present during any new invasive experiment and provides advice to research teams to ensure security and compliance with ethical rules.
- Plays an advisory role with management, animal facility staff, researchers and teaching staff and monitors the risks for the health and general safety of all users.
- Works in collaboration with the other veterinarian in order to ensure an optimal care program, including the sharing of custody and the occasional assumption of responsibility for tasks normally performed by this veterinarian.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- DVM or equivalent degree with relevant experience (including experience in private practice).
- Eligibility for veterinary licensure in the Province of Quebec.
- Have a working knowledge of the accreditation standards of the CCAC and Health Canada.
- Have an interest in teamwork and to know how to maintain good relationships with a variety of people.
- Have recognized experience in an advisory role and demonstrate customer service skills.
- Have the courage to act while demonstrating diplomacy in your interventions.
- Fluency in spoken and written French is an asset. English-speaking applications will still be considered, given that most of the research teams are bilingual and there will be the possibility of working as a team with the other veterinarian, who is bilingual. However, candidates must show interest in following a personalized French learning program offered free of charge on site.


COVID-19 considerations:
